8 MEMBER

9 A statement with reasonable particularity of the relevant facts upon which the charges are based,
10 to allow the house to balance the various interests involved - including the particular needs of the
11 house, fairness to an accused member and regard for potential criminal prosecutions and the
12 criminal justice system.

13 Mrs. Charles J. (Dayan Hochman-) Vigil is the member of the State of New Mexico House of
14 Representatives, District 15, Bernalillo County.

1 SECTION 1.) NEW DAY FOR NM (CHAS VIGIL, TREAS) BRIEF WITH CITATIONS
2 Records of the Secretary of State shows that a campaign committee (New Day For NM, Charles
3 Vigil, Treasurer) made expenditures, not reasonably related to serve constituents, without
4 limitations on use, to a consultant:
5 who fails to disclose contracts with Virgin Galactic, a foreign for-profit corporation that
6 influenced legislation;
7 introduced by the candidate with effect on Facilities Lease with Spaceport America;
8 The New Mexico Spaceport Authority executed the Facilities Lease with Virgin Galactic on or
9 about December 31, 2008. The Facilities Lease is alleged to be amended on or about December
10 31, 2018. The Legislature of the State of New Mexico (HB68 sponsor: Hochman- Vigil, 2021
11 Regular) limits the liability for the operation of the Spaceport; and, the Spaceport Authority and
12 Virgin Galactic will renegotiate the limits of liability contained in the Facilities Lease (15.6.
13 Change in Limits.) for comprehensive aviation liability policies of insurance, including Aircraft
14 liability, passenger liability, Airport/Spaceport premises liability, contractual liability and
15 products/completed
16 operations, from no less than Two Hundred Million and No/100s Dollars (\$200,000,000.00) to
17 one million dollars (\$1,000,000) annually.

28 tenant, Virgin Galactic, might reconsider and re-evaluate its presence at the spaceport and in
29 New Mexico, should the protections not be provided.

1 Beyond affecting Virgin Galactic, NMSA believes the same concerns will possibly negatively
2 impact its ability to attract other space flight entities, tenants, and users. In the recent past a
3 number of current and potential customers of Spaceport America have
4 indicated an unwillingness to move to New Mexico and operate from Spaceport America absent
5 the protection afforded by this legislation.
